

TOP TIPS FOR YOUR DOG DURING *Fireworks*

Before the event

- Prepare a den for your dog in their favourite place.
- Plug in an **Adaptil Diffuser** near the den and provide your dog with toys and treats.

On the day of the event

- Walk your dog before dusk. This reduces the likelihood of fireworks being let off.
- Provide distractions such as a new chew or toy. Close curtains and put the TV or music on to mask the sound of fireworks.
- Don't punish your dog when he is scared.
- **IMPORTANT** Ignore any fearful behaviour such as panting, shaking and whining, this will only make your dog more distressed.
- Try not to leave your dog alone when fireworks are going off. Keep your routine as normal as possible.

After the event

- Leave the **Adaptil Diffuser** plugged in for at least a week.
- Behavioural therapy may be required once the firework season is over.
